Trade Exchange

In 2022, Venezuela ranked 58th on the list of the Lebanese export sources while ranking 25th on the list of the Lebanese import sources accounting for 1% of total imports.

In 2022, preparations of vegetables and fruits alongside animal/ vegetable fats and oils were among the main Lebanese exports to Venezuela. More specifically, the categories with the highest value were olive oil (HS 15.09.09) with a value of \$ 463 thousand and Nuts (20.08.19) with a value of \$ 361 thousand.

The category the most imported among jewellery was Gold in ingots form (71.08.12.10) with a value of \$ 147 million. Also, Wood charcoal (HS 44.02.9) accounts for \$ 2.6 million worth of imports from Venezuela to Lebanon.



Lebanon has the highest supply capacity in Generating sets with diesel engine, <=75kVA. Uncooked pasta is the product that faces the strongest demand potential in Venezuela

Lebanon can work on increasing its production and export of generating sets to Venezuela, given its high supply and potential highlighted. Also, medicaments have to potential to be exported from Lebanon but their supply are limited as the source mentions.
